



Fat Daddio's anodized aluminum and silicone bakeware is manufactured to help meet the demands of a busy kitchen. Our products are designed to provide consistent and reliable baking results. Due to the anodizing process, some pans may contain blemishes in their appearance. These are truly a mark of the craftsman and are common in anodizing. These marks will not affect the baking performance or life of the pan in any way.

Washing Instructions:

Fat Daddio's bakeware should be hand-washed in warm soapy water and towel-dried. Do not use bleaches, abrasive soaps, wire brushes, scouring sponges, or other aggressive cleaning tools as they can damage the surface of the bakeware.

Use Instructions:

Anodized Aluminum Bakeware – Due to the efficiencies in how our bakeware performs, we suggest you reduce all recipes by 25 degrees. We recommend that you apply a baking release spray or grease and flour each individual pan to ensure the best release.

Silicone Bakeware – Our silicone baking pans are manufactured to provide years of easy-release baking. These pans require very little to no greasing or release sprays. Our silicone bakeware is temperature safe from -40° F to 550° F.

Polycarbonate Candy Molds – Our polycarbonate candy/chocolate molds require no greasing. The finish of the material leaves a high shine and gloss on chocolates and hard candies.
